1. REGISTRATION AND SUMMER CLASSES

- 1) Registration : Start From April 13 (Monday)
- 2) Class Period : June 1 (Mon) ~ July 31 (Fri) – 8 Weeks *Academy will be closed from 6/29/2026 (Mon) – 7/3/2025 (Fri)
- 3) Class will be cancelled if there is less than minimum student number (Will notify by May 25 if class is cancelled / 100% refund)
- 4) Students may arrive for class time only and should be picked up at the end of class

2-1. SPECIAL CLASS (STUDENTS CAN FORM A CLASS WITH PRIVATE MEMBERS)

3. CLASS INFORMATION

1) Book Club

Books will be classics and award-winning choices. Classes will focus on reading aloud for pronunciation. Focus on new vocabulary, characters, themes and overall plot understanding during class discussions. Homework will include reading and writing or short answer questions.

*IEPA Book Club is not AR type of reading.

2) Writing Class

Each class will include essays & writing homework evaluation for corrections and improvement. New essay styles will be taught and explained with practice. Homework will be a complete writing each week using the 6 formats. There will be a strong focus on grammar. Level 2 will be learning basic skills.

3) Current Events (News Study)

Students will be learning map skills, world leaders, events happening in the news and governments around the world with comparing and contrasting. Topics may include business, auto industry, government, science, changing cultures, technology and trends. Classes are interactive with discussions and videos. Students will be writing about the topics each week for homework.
